Japan grants additional 18.21 million USD to Lebanon

Alarmed by the protracted Syrian crisis and the continued pressures on host countries, the Government of Japan decided on the 3rd of February 2015 to grant an additional eighteen million US dollars (US\$18,210,412) to Lebanon. The aid that will be channeled through the following international organizations: UNHCR, WFP, UNRWA, UNICEF, UNDP, UNODC, ICRC, IFRC and Japan Platform (JPF) will help in mitigating the adverse impact of the aforementioned crisis on the Lebanese host communities and on the Syrian refugees in Lebanon.

The Government of Japan has extended its support to Lebanon with contributions totaling more than 78 million US dollars since February 2012.
