Japan Provides Waste Collection Trucks to Municipalities in Baalbek

The Embassy of Japan funds solid waste collection trucks for the municipalities in the Caza of Baalbek, in order to improve the living conditions of the residents.

To fund the project, on March 05 2018, H.E. Mr. Matahiro Yamaguchi, Ambassador of Japan to Lebanon signed a grant contract with Dr. Rami Lakkis, Director of LOST, a local NGO that provides various services including education, humanitarian assistance, and health to the people of Baalbek.

With a fund of USD 90,400 through the Grant Assistance for Grass-roots Human Security Program (GGP), LOST in collaboration with the municipalities in Baalbek will be able to provide a better living environment to at least 45,000 residents of the villages that suffer from pollution and severe waste management problems.
