Japan Supports the Municipality of Kfardenis

The Embassy of Japan supports the construction of a water tank in Kfardenis, Rashaya, in order to provide clean water to the residents of the village.

To Fund the Project, on March 5 2019, H.E. Mr. Matahiro Yamaguchi, Ambassador of Japan to Lebanon signed a grant contract with Mr. Izzat Al Kaderi, Mayor of the municipality of Kfardenis.

Through the Grant Assistance for Grass-roots Human Security Program (GGP), the Embassy is providing a grant of USD 36,730 to fund the installation of a water tank and a filtration system. The project will allow the municipality to provide clear water to around 3,750 residents and Syrian refugees.
