Due to visits by foreign dignitaries, especially on October 22 and 23, major traffic restrictions will be in place on the Metropolitan Expressway, in central Tokyo and around the airports for an extended period, and therefore, traffic congestion will be expected.

- Please do not drive your car to the airport. Use public transport.

Please refrain from driving your car to either Tokyo International or Narita International airport during this period and use a train, monorail or other form of public transport instead.

- If catching a flight, ensure that you allow extra time before your flight when arriving at the airport

Airport security has been strengthened since September 13 (Fri), including more extensive security screening at Tokyo International Airport, Narita International Airport and all other airports in Japan.

All passengers are advised to arrive at the airport well ahead of their flight time.

- Some flights may be delayed

Due to the increased number of flights during this period, some arrivals or departures could be delayed at Tokyo International and Narita International Airports. Thank you for your understanding. We regret any inconvenience this may cause for air passengers.
