Development Issue	[Current Status and Issues] The country has been hit with compound crises, including a massive influx of Syrian refugees (since 2012), the first default in the country's history (2020), a major explosion at the port of Beirut (2020), influence of the COVID 19 pandecmic, currency collapse, hyperinflation (especially in food prices) and other crises, with public services not functioning, and chronic electricity shortages seriously affecting access to safe water and sanitation. Furthermore, with the deteriorating situation in southern Lebanon since October 2023 due to the clashes between Israel-Hamas and other Palestinian militants, humanitarian assistance to socially vulnerable groups (women, children, people with special needs, refugees, etc.) is indispensable in the short run, as well as medium— and long-term development assistance for Lebanon's economic and social recovery.
